

“Reconstruction and display of iconic cultural sites with high tourism potential in the Euroregion Ruse-Giurgiu”

Total budget: €1 426 760,12

Duration: 36 months

The aim is to use the common history of Ruse and Giurgiu as a basis for creating modern, integrated tourism products and services that will be jointly managed and promoted. Thus Euroregion Ruse-Giurgiu will become an attractive tourism destination, which will attract tourists from Bulgaria and Romania, as well as from other European countries.

The project is implemented under Programme “Interreg V-A Romania-Bulgaria” 2014-2020, Priority Axis 2 “Green Region”, Specific objective 2.1 “To improve the sustainable use of natural heritage and resources and cultural heritage”. The project duration is 36 months.

The project includes the following activities:

- **Reconstruction of the high body of the building;**
- **Covering of the ring terraces and stands above the main entrance;**
- **Stylobate – ventilation, external heat and waterproofing;**
- **Reinforcement of the construction of the main entrance and drainage;**
- **Internal renovation works;**
- **Architectural Lighting;**
- **Exterior lighting;**
- **Interior lighting.**

Repairs of the Pantheon of the National Revival Heroes in Ruse:

- Reinforcement of the construction of the main entrance, including installation of guard rails and drainage;
- Internal renovation works;
- Replacement of existing stone lining;

- External thermal insulation and waterproofing;
- External and internal architectural lighting;
- Cleaning and replacement of the gilding of the dome.

Valorisation of the area surrounding Giurgiu Fortress:

- Access platform on the eastern side of the site;
- Pedestrian route on the southern dyke of the land - to the canal;
- The “Northern Wall” route of the fortress, bed trails, urban furniture, alveoli bed and alveoli dyke;
- Landscaping the fortress surroundings and landscaping the northern dyke;
- Ambient lighting - functional and architectural lighting;
- Installation of billboards with images of the fortress from various historical periods.
